We would like to inform you about upcoming emergency culvert investigations works at the bottom of Fore Street in Kingsbridge.

The highway requires maintenance, and these essential excavations and investigations will check the culvert which is beneath the road at the bottom of Fore Street and undertake repairs if the situation if required.

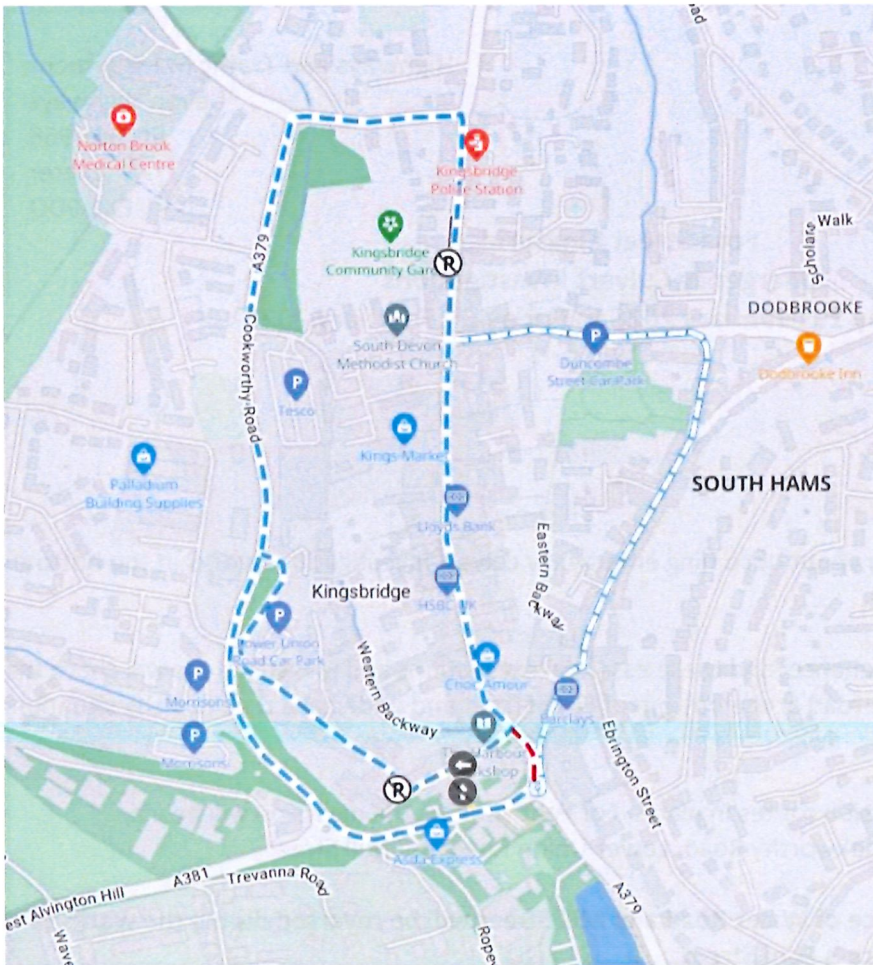
There will be two local diversion routes in place. For light vehicles the diversion will be via, Plymouth Road, the A379 Cookworthy Road, Lower Union Road and Mill Street.

The one way system in Prince of Wales Road and Mill Street will be reversed during the works to allow smaller vehicles to access Fore Street.

For HGV's, the diversion will be via Plymouth Road, Duncombe Road, Church Street, the A39 Ilbert Road and Cookworthy Road. There will be a temporary loading area created close to the museum for business use.

Any changes to the start date or duration will be shown on advisory signs on site. We will do our best to complete the work quickly and minimise disruption. Your co-operation and understanding are greatly appreciated.

Please see the map for the full road closure and works area highlighted in **red** on the map below with the official diversion routes which will be fully signed throughout. Please note that drivers with local knowledge may wish to use local roads but that Devon County Council will only promote the official diversion route.
